Forms

Arrival and Departure

Please escort your child to room 232 on the second floor by 8:45 a.m. each morning.

Check your child in with Mary Grey Moses. We will begin boarding the bus for camp each day at 8:45 a.m. and will leave for camp promptly at 9:00 a.m. Do not send your child unattended to the second floor.

If you have any questions or unfinished paper work please be sure to arrive by 8:30 a.m. on Monday morning so that your child is ready to board the bus at 8:45 a.m. The bus must leave promptly at 9:00 a.m. or the children will miss part of the day's activities. We have a full day planned for Monday.

If you would like to meet us at Camp Lookout please arrive there at 9:30 a.m.

Directions to Camp Lookout are provided on the last page.



We will return to the church by 4:30 p.m. each day and you may pick your child up from the parking lot of the Oak Street Center at that time.

If you are picking your child up from Camp Lookout please do so at 3:45 pm.

Label all belongings with your child's name.

Please be sure to put your child's name on his or her lunch cooler, backpack, swim suit, towel, clothing (clothes get jumbled in the bathhouse), sunscreen, and extra shoes.

Lunches and Snacks

Please pack your child a hearty lunch, lots of water, and an afternoon snack. A small cooler with an ice pack works well to keep the lunch fresh on hot days. The children work and play hard and they are always very hungry for a good lunch! We will have a time for snacks in the afternoon.

____ **Swim Suit**

The children will carry their swimsuit from the campsite to the bath house. Please put the swim suit in a plastic bag inside your child's backpack. This will help your child get his or her swimsuit to bathhouse without dropping any pieces on the walk and will give him, or her, a way to get the wet suit back home at the end of the day. Life guards from Camp Lookout are on duty at the pool and each child must pass a swim test before being allowed in the deep end of the pool.



____ **Towel**

Please bring a towel to dry off after the pool. The water can be cold.

____ **Shoes**

Closed toed tennis shoes are mandatory each day or your child will not be able to participate in camp activities. Please make sure that your child's shoes are comfortable, outdoor shoes. They will be hiking and getting dirty.

Each group goes on a creek walk one day during the week. **Shoes are mandatory for the creek walk** and must be appropriate water shoes with a closed toe or a pair of old tennis shoes. Please pack an extra pair of shoes for the creek hike. Crocks will not stay on your child's feet in the water and are not appropriate shoes for the creek walk.

____ **Extra Tee Shirt and Shorts**

Please put a change of clothes in your child's backpack. They may never need it but if they get wet or muddy they will be glad to have it.

____ **Sunscreen**

We will be outside each day. Please be sure to put sunscreen on your child's arms and face before he or she leaves home and to send a bottle so that they can reapply lotion during the day.

____ **Jacket**

It can be much cooler on the mountain so please send a jacket with your child. We had a lot of cold children last year.

Directions

From Chattanooga, on I-24, take Exit 178 (Lookout Mtn. Exit). Follow signs to Lookout Mtn., left on Broad Street. Travel 1.4 miles and turn left on TN. Ave. (this becomes St. Elmo Ave., then Ga. Hwy. 193). Go approximately 8.9 miles, then turn right at Nick-A-Jack Rd. for 4 miles. Turn left at stop sign. Lookout is 1/2 miles on right. Look for the yellow mailbox.
